This was a fun, companion event to fall's Second Summer Cycle featuring dozens of indoor bikes and instructor-led 25-minute spin classes. The beneficiary was the Youth Athletic Foundation. I was joined by Erin Lynch, Phil Kirby, and Kim Pzegeo and we managed to fill all 6 slots on our team! Pat Lentell indicated that about \$2000 was raised!



The second club meeting of the year was held on Thursday, April 4th at the Portside Tavern in Hyannis with about 15 attendees, including most of the board. The full meeting minutes should be attached here, so I'll just pick out some highlights and more timely events.

Jack Harrison / C4 Memorial Ride: We've scheduled this ride for Sunday, June 9th. Again, this will be an 8AM start time leaving from the Yarmouth Rail Trail parking lot. We hope to have a century, metric century, and possibly a half-metric mapped out. This is an unsupported ride, so please come prepared. Also note that not all speed groups are guaranteed to be no-drop.
